1	Dressing Gown

1	Wash bag, including hairbrush/comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and shower gel (please note that we do not allow children to use aerosol deodorants in school)
1	Shoe cleaning kit
1	Duvet bag (large enough to hold a duvet and pillow)
1	Weekend / overnight bag
1	Tuck box (optional). These can be ordered through the Matrons if requested.
1	Blanket / throw for bed (optional)
1	Trunk / large suitcase

In addition, boarders are encouraged to bring the following items:

- Teddy or treasured soft toy
- Books
- Photographs to decorate pinboard
- Letter writing set, including addresses for family members (we write letters home each Sunday morning)

All items must be clearly labelled

Notes for boarders

At the beginning of term and when returning to school after weekends out or after sleepouts or half terms, boarders should return in school uniform.

All boarders' uniform will remain at school from September until July and will be replaced as necessary from the second hand shop or new as required. If you would prefer only new items, please inform the Matrons.

Although all items will be sent home at the end of the summer term, only personal belongings (duvets, footwear, home clothes and tuckboxes) will be sent home at the end of the Autumn and Spring terms. If you require any specific items to be sent home for the holidays, or indeed at any time, please give the Matrons plenty of notice.

Overseas children may leave their personal belongings (duvets etc.) at school during the holidays, although a small charge will be made for storage, cleaning and laundry.

All boarders' laundry is done on the premises, at no cost, but please ensure that all items are machine washable and can be tumble-dried. A charge will be made for any items that require dry cleaning.

Boarders may bring in a mobile phone and/or iPad/tablet if they wish but **these must be clearly named**. Specific times are allocated for the use of electrical devices and we enjoy Tech-Free Tuesdays and Thursdays, giving the children time to play which is so important.
