- Provide equality of opportunity for all boarders regardless of ethnic origins, culture, gender, religion, abilities and character.
- Recognise and value all members of the boarding community as unique individuals.
- Encourage and maintain close links with parents, families and friends as a vital partnership in the growth and well-being of the children.
- House all boarders within comfortable and suitable accommodation, free of obvious physical dangers and hazards.
- Provide opportunities for boarders to develop qualities of leadership, an understanding of the importance of team work, confidence in personal responsibility and initiative.
